

St Aidans RSPB Nature Park

Join us on a visit to St Aidans RSPB Nature Park at Swillington. This is a haven for wildlife including bitterns, avocets, black terns, skylarks and meadow pipits. There are accessible paths around parts of the park and lakes as well as more adventurous walks for those who wish to explore more.

There is also a small cafe with a terrace giving amazing views across the lakes if you just want to sit and enjoy the view and the atmosphere. The cafe sells snacks and cakes as well as hot and cold drinks (including their own bird friendly coffee) or there are picnic tables if you wanted to bring your own food.




We have an **accessible minibus** to take us to St Aidans and it will be leaving from the **Caring Together premises, Charing Cross, Woodhouse at 11.00am**. We can also pick up before this at Little London Community Centre and, if you are not able to get to a pick up point, we will be able to collect you from home.

We will leave St Aidans for the return journey at 2pm.
