Leeds Black History Walk

Discover, with Joe of Heritage Corner Leeds, unseen ancient and local narratives with African connections. The guided walk provides informative perspectives on historical facts, to provoke questions and/or reflection.

The Leeds Black History Walk was launched in 2009 by Joe Williams, as part of a Chapeltown community initiative with the Leeds Bi-Centenary Transformation Project, to transform how Africans are perceived in history.

The walk lasts 2 hours & is interactive. Questions and group discussions are welcomed, but steered by the walk-guide for timekeeping. Participation in discourse is of course optional. If you wish to simply come and absorb the rich information then this more than ok too.

The walk will go ahead, in sun and rain, each adding their own quality to the atmosphere of the stories. However, we advise walkers to wear/bring appropriate items for protection against the weather. There are plenty of sitting down points along the way

Thank you to everyone who takes part in our monthly Prize Draw, it helps raise much needed funds to support our work. The draws take place on the third Monday of each month.


