# **Charing Cross Re-development**

We have been informed that the long awaited redevelopment of Charing Cross Square is due to start in November 2023 and is expected to take about 12 weeks. The plans involve resurfacing the square, adding trees and a new sign, putting steps at the front of the square to the pavement (near the bus stop) and changing the steps at the back of the square—taking away part of the large step area to create more space as you enter the square from the back and repairing the steps to make them safer.

This work has been planned since before Covid and we hope it will make a big difference to this, previously fairly neglected, square. It is however going to cause some disruption. The contractors have assured us that they will ensure access to all the businesses in the square.

Here at Caring Together we have lots of activities happening over this time and we are intending to continue these as planned if we can. If you are planning to visit us, or attend an event/activity, and you have any concerns about it, please contact us.

# Winter Warmth and Wellbeing

We want to start this section by saying <u>please make sure that you keep yourself, and your home,</u> <u>warm enough</u>. This is especially important as we get older and become more susceptible to the cold.

#### Winter Warmth items from Caring Together

Caring Together will have a small stock of items, for our members, to help keep warm this winter and this includes "Hotties" (microwavable heat pads), blankets, duvets, gloves, hats, scarves, and socks. These will be available at our premises at Charing Cross, and at our get-togethers and activities that are held in our own premises. Or you can call us if you would like some of these items and we can arrange to get them to you.

## Help if you are struggling to pay your bills:

If you have energy debt or think you will not be able to pay your energy bills, it's important to contact your supplier – most suppliers have hardship funds to help customers but they do also have an obligation to help you find a solution, so speak to them as soon as possible. There may also be help available from other sources. Caring Together can help our members to look at the options and to access the support that is available so please contact us. Even if you are not a member, we can try and put you in touch with the organisations that can offer help.

#### Can you save on other bills?

A number of phone and broadband companies have cheaper 'social tariffs' for people on low incomes – it is worth calling your provider to ask or look at other providers and it may be worth switching.

Yorkshire Water also have schemes to help customers on a low income, you can contact them for advice on 0345 1 299 299.

You can, of course, ask Caring Together to look at these options with you.

## **Financial Support for Winter 2023-24**

- Winter fuel payments will be paid to those who were at or over state pension age on 25th September 2023 and will be either £500 or £600 per household this year. You should get a letter telling you what you are due and it will be paid into your bank.
- ◆ Warm Home Discount—this scheme gives you £150, credited directly to your fuel bill (providing your energy supplier is part of the scheme). It will be awarded to people getting Pension Credit and also to some people on low incomes and in properties with high energy costs. You don't need to claim—you should get a letter telling you if you are eligible.
- ◆ Cost of living payment—there will be a further £300 cost of living payment for people on some means tested benefits, including Pension Credit, Income based ESA or JSA, Universal Credit or Tax Credits. This should be paid into your bank account between 31st October and 19th November. There will be a further payment in Spring 2024, exact dates are not confirmed yet.
- ◆ Cold Weather Payments—an additional payment of £25 for those on means tested benefits if the weather in your area is zero Celsius or below for 7 consecutive days between 1st November 2023 and 31st March 2024. Paid automatically for each 7 day period.

All of these payments/discounts should be made without you having to apply for them.

Watch out for scams asking you to apply for them. The DWP has said it will never ask you for personal details or banking info over text or email.

If you think you should be entitled to one of the above and don't receive it, Caring Together can help you look into it, if you wish.
